### **NYC Building Code Revisions**

Chapter 33 of the NYC Building Code was revised and became effective on December 31 2014. Chapter 33 covers construction and demolition safety and applies to all types of construction, alteration, demolition work and to all types of buildings.

The goals of the revision to Chapter 33 were to

- Add Requirements To Enhance Construction Safety
- Incorporate New Technologies and Industry Best Practices
- Clarify Ambiguities in Code Language
- Consolidate Safety-Related Regulations Into Chapter 33

The presentation will focus on significant changes to Chapter 33 that all contractors, safety professionals, and design professionals should be aware of.

### **Prevention through Design: *Sustainable Innovation in Safety Management***
